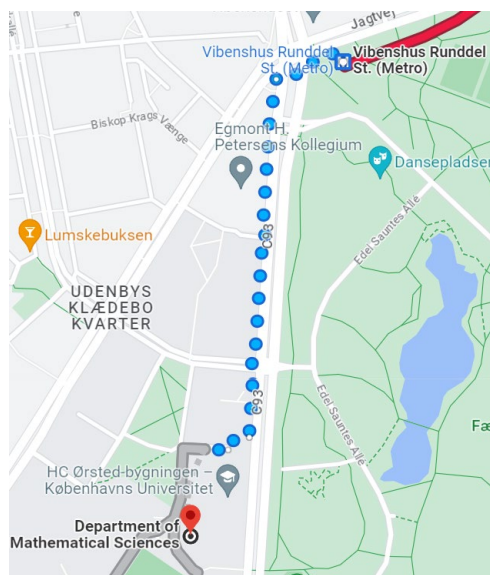
Directions from Airport/Central train station to venue

From the airport, the easiest way to get to the venue is via the metro.

- Take Metro line M1/M2 to Kongens Nytorv St
- Change to the M3 line (via Østerport) to Vibenshus Runddel St
- Walk from Vibenshus Runddel to venue (650)

If you arrive by train, most trains stop at the Central station called Hovedbanegaarden. From here take the Metro line M3 (via Kongens Nytorv) to Vibenshus Runddel and walk from here.

Directions from city center to venue

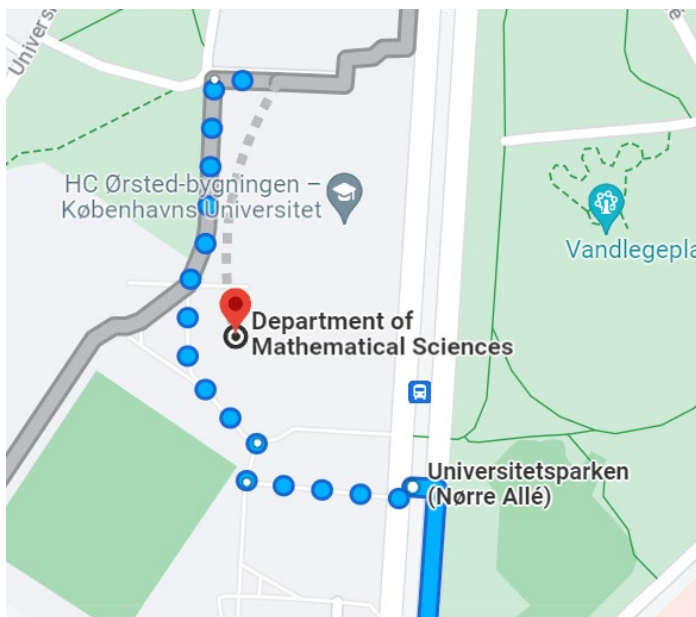
If your accommodation is in the city, you can either take the metro M3 line (via Østerport) to Vibenshus Runddel metro and walk from there (see map above) or alternatively you can take the bus, e.g. from Nørreport station.

At Nørreport St (Nørre Voldgade) bus stop, you can take any of the following busses.

- 150S towards Kokkedal St – 3 stops
- 185 towards Klampenborg St – 4 stops
- 184 towards Holte St – 4 stops

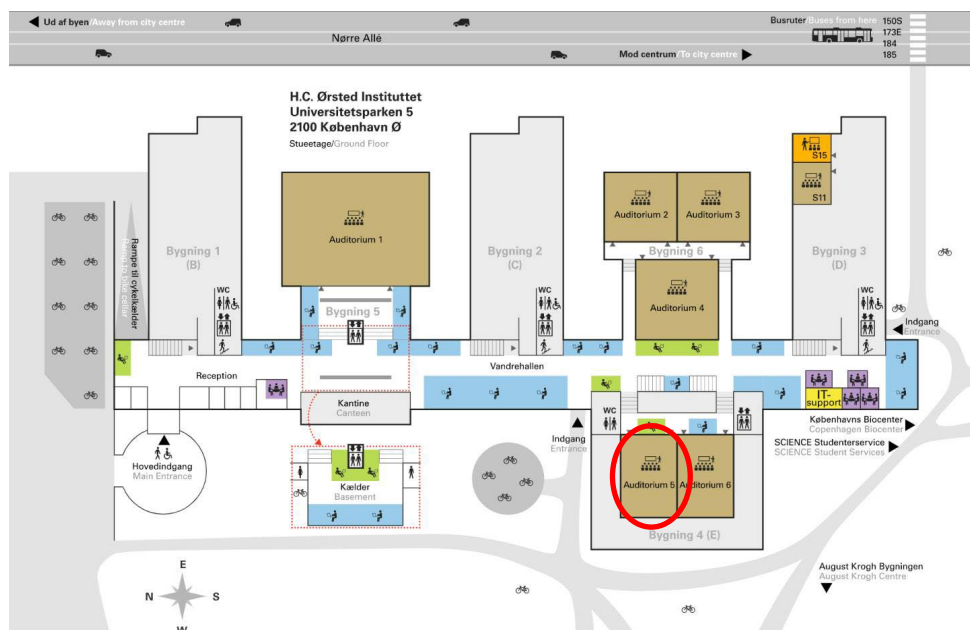
Get off at Universitetsparken (Nørre Allé) and walk from to H.C. Ørsted Institute/building

Please see below a map of the H. C. Ørsted Institute and how to locate Aud. 5.

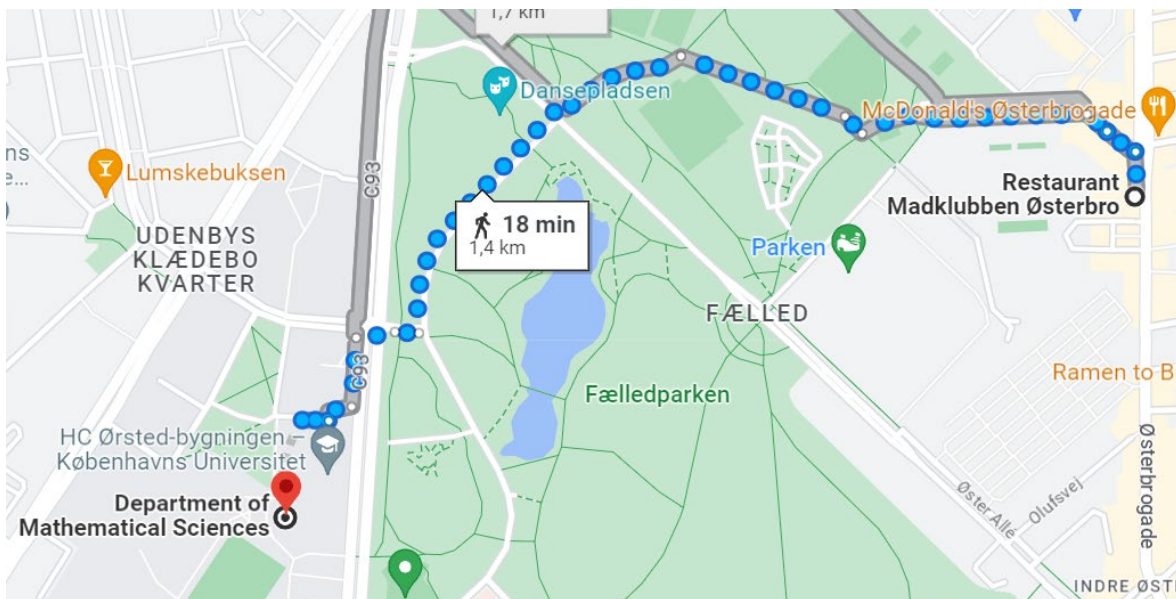


Dinner: Restaurant Madklubben Østerbro, Aug. 10 at 19.00
